Who we are:

Rozelle Neighbourhood Centre is a community, disability and aged care organisation focusing on wellbeing and providing opportunities for people to belong and be themselves in the community. We coordinate targeted programs, services and activities which aim to improve the wellbeing of locals through:

- community hub which enables locals to thrive in the community
- supporting people with a disability to reach their full potential
- showcasing the work of artists with disabilities
- supporting older people in their home to age in place

The centre has been supporting the community for 41 years changing with the demographic and needs of the community. We are governed by a Voluntary Management Committee, and under the direction of a General Manager to employ a team of Coordinators, Support Workers and volunteers to implement all our programs.

Programs include:

Community Hub

Providing information, referral and access: Pop Up Pantry & Wardrobe, Knit & Natter, Inner West Tenant Group, Habit Change Group, Yoga, Singing Rozellas, ARC Choir, Belvoir Bus, Legal Advice, Tax Help, No Interest Loans, Food Vouchers, and counselling.

Ever After Theatre

Catering for new and emerging artists for over 17 years with an interest in creating and performing group devised work. Ever After have performed locally and at Carriageworks, Opera House and PACT.

My Aged Care

Supporting older people to stay connected to their community and age in place with the assistance of social and domestic support workers.

NDIS Wellbeing Team

Wellbeing Team are our innovative approach to the NDIS. We believe that people should have genuine choice and control over their support. We also provide Plan Management services enabling people to have a greater choice of Service Providers and Support Coordinators.

Recreation And Peer Support (RAPS) & Saturday Club

Provides a calendar of activities for people with a disability to engage in social events. These activities connect people with a disability with each other and the wider community.

Red Door Arts

Art by Night Music, drama and visual art classes for adults with an intellectual disability residing in the inner west area. Leisure Options classes connect those looking to learn new skills, express themselves creatively and engage with others through a shared artistic interest.

Teen Theatre Crew

Drama classes for young people with disabilities including children on the spectrum enabling young people the opportunity to connect and express themselves in a supportive environment.

Sponsorship Packages

2. funds two laptops for hub space to connect locals to the internet
3. Funds writing workshops for one year for people living in social housing

3. funds workshop materials, from costumes art supplies to musical instruments

1. funds art supplies for workshops
2. funds the bus hire for one outing
3. purchase food vouchers for 50 people
